Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop in the beginning hiring 4 individuals. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Throughout 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is among the leading worldwide makers within the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's original hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively pursue better business opportunities. Throughout the last sixty years, the industry of material handling has grown into a really advanced field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its development. Cascade at the moment continues to grow as the premier supplier of forklift accessories and various related items. The company feels assured in their ability in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the world market.

Through the 1950's, Cascade began to fabricate, design, and advertise its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was built in the year 1956, to accommodate all plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current headquarters. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total staff reached 180 employees and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

A second production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its production facilities throughout the U.S. with locations in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade merchandise are made internationally thanks to lots of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is built to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to buying 5 companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide best in forks.
